Image Format:

You may submit four entries either by CD, photographs, slides or e-mail attachments. Mark each image with your name, title of the work, and entry number (#1, #2, etc.). Slides, photographs and CD will be returned if a self-addressed stamped envelope is supplied. For slides and photographs indicate "top" as top of image. Slides must be mounted in the standardized carousel compatible 2" x 2" plastic or paper mounts (no glass).

Shipping:

Artists are responsible for the transport of their pieces to and from the Museum. The Museum can package the returned work, but shipping costs will be the artist's responsibility. Shipped items should be packed in reusable cartons or crates that are convenient to repack.

Return of Work:

All work that was hand delivered may be picked up during this time period:

Jan. 10-13, 17-20: 10:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

All other artwork will be shipped using UPS. Shipping fees must be received by Dec. 31. Make checks payable to the Johnson-Humrickhouse Museum.

Specifications:

- ◇ Artist must have a connection to Coshocton County (having lived, worked, or spent time here)
- ◇ Applicant may submit up to four works. Jury review is by digital media, photograph or slide. Application may also be e-mailed with image attachments.
- ◇ Jury fee is \$10.
- ◇ Artwork must be available Oct. 1— January 7, be ready to hang and not exceed 42 in. in height or width.
- ◇ JHM takes a 25% commission on the sale of all artwork. Please price your art to include this.
- ◇ Submission to this exhibition constitutes acceptance of stated conditions and includes permission to photograph accepted work for publicity and educational purposes.
- ◇ JHM reserves the right to reject, upon arrival, any piece because of unacceptable craftsmanship, quality or subject matter not discernable in submitted image. Artist is responsible for the shipping cost of returned work.
